

Pavement Improvements Tiverton



What's happening?

The Rhode Island Department of Transportation (RIDOT) is performing a roadway improvement project in Tiverton. The project includes removal of existing road surface and replacement with new. Main Street will include removal of existing curb and sidewalk and replacement with new. All new roads will be restriped, new signage installed, and clean and flush drainage fixtures.

When is it happening?

The paving plan is as follows:

RI Route 77 paving (Main Road) from Highland Road to Evans Avenue. Mid July – Mid November 2024.

Highland Road paving from Bridgeport Road to RI Route 77. Early September – Late December 2024.

Paving operations are Sunday through Thursday nights 8:00 pm to 6:00 am. Please expect construction noise. Detours will be in place to ensure traffic flow. Off road operations such as sidewalk installation and curb work will be completed 7:00 am-3:30 pm.
